All interested participants are kindly invited to present the latest results of their scientific work in one of the IRPhE'2014 subject areas.

The deadline for submissions is **15 November, 2014**. The Local Organizing Committee will do their best to give notify the participant of the final decision on the revised paper within two weeks after receipt. Thus, early submission is encouraged.

Contributed, full-length papers must be written in English and should report previously unpublished work. The authors are responsible for both the content and style of their contributions. No editing or re-typing will be carried out by the conference organizers, and accepted contributions will be reproduced without reduction or modification. Contributions that do not conform to the format described below may be rejected.

Each contributed paper must be submitted in two files:

- (a) A Microsoft Word (alternatively Open Office or Rich Text)
- (b) and its corresponding PDF file.

Contributions submitted by Fax or Postal mail will not be accepted.

All abstracts will be printed on a booklet that will be distributed to all registered participants at the start of the conference. All papers presented at the conference will be available on a Compact Disc.

In order to have a paper published in the conference proceedings, at least one of the authors must have paid the registration fee before 15 September, 2014.

2. Recommendations for the text

2.1. Format

Full length papers should be typewritten for A4 format paper, with minimum and maximum lengths of 2 and 4 pages per paper, respectively, including figures and references. There are no page limitations for the invited papers. After the abstract, please use Times New Roman font at one column. Set the margins as

Top, Bottom	2.5 cm	(A4 paper)
Left	2.0 cm	(A4 paper)
Right	2.0 cm	(A4 paper)

The fonts must be all in Times, as follows:

Title	14 Bold, centered
Authors names	12, normal, centered
Affiliations	10, Italic, centered
Main text	11, justified left and right
Figure caption	10, normal
Major headings	11 bold
Subheadings	11 bold (flush left on a separate line).

2.2. Miscellaneous

The topic number (according to the Scientific Program) must be written on the top right corner of the first page.

2.3. Figures, tables and equations

Papers may include figures and tables. A caption should be written under each figure and above each table.

Equation numbers must be in parentheses and placed flush with right-hand margin of the column. The pages must not be numbered.

3. References

List all references at the end of the paper. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number inside brackets [1] and the reference listed as in the following example:
