

IMMORTALITY OF GENIUS

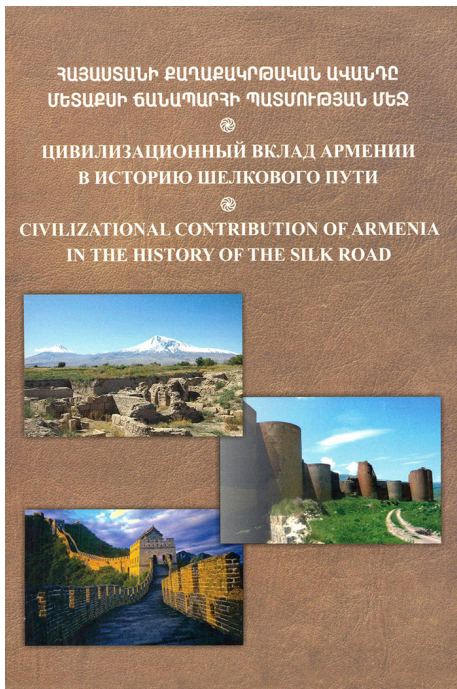
