

AMERICANS WILLING TO ASSIST ARMENIANS

Washington, Sept. 24.—Several American philanthropists have signified a willingness to provide funds for bringing to this country persecuted Armenians in the Far East who desire to emigrate, according to information that has reached the state department from the American board of foreign missions. No names have been disclosed. What the attitude of the Turkish government might be toward such a movement has not been learned.

Ambassador Morgenthau today was instructed to investigate rumors that American missionaries had been killed in recent Turkish military operations against the Armenians.
